RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AMENDING THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT, ESTABLISHING PROJECT ST017 AND APPROVING A TEMPORARY WAIVER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION 2002-5865 FOR CONSTRUCTION RELATED TO SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, an existing storm drain crossing San Marcos Boulevard west of Viewpoint Drive, is in need of repair due to impacts created by an adjacent development; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Improvement Program Budget needs to be amended to incorporate a new project to accomplish repairs on said storm drain; and

WHEREAS, the City has executed a reimbursement agreement with the development that impacted the storm drain; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to move forward with this project expeditiously; and

WHEREAS, City Council previously adopted Resolution 2002-5865 which specifies work within the San Marcos Boulevard public right-of-way which necessitates a lane closure, in either direction, must occur during nighttime off-peak hours or on weekends; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will require lane closures to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the closure and had determined it necessary to accommodate the work in an expeditious, safe, and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the expeditious execution of this project will rectify the damage to the storm drain so that it will function properly, and will truncate the period during which nighttime noise and attendant impacts to sensitive receptors will occur as a result of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- 1. The Capital Improvement Program budget is hereby amended establishing the Project ST017 as shown in the attached budget sheet.
- 2. The requirements of Resolution 2002-5865 are waived to allow for the closure of San Marcos Boulevard as part of ST017 as approved by the City Engineer and required for the expeditious delivery of the project.
