RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS, AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID, AND DELEGATING TO AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD, NEGOTIATE, FINALIZE, AND EXECUTE THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR THE SAN MARCOS BLVD. DUAL LEFT-TURN LANE EXTENSION AT RANCHO SANTA FE RD. PROJECT (CIP #ST005)

WHEREAS, construction documents for the San Marcos Blvd. Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Rd. Project (CIP #ST005, "Project") have been substantially completed; and

WHEREAS, the Project has been determined to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15301, Existing Facilities Class 1(c); and

WHEREAS, the Project improvements will include extending the westbound dual left-turn lane on San Marcos Boulevard and Rancho Santa Fe Road intersection by approximately 160 feet; and

WHEREAS, the Project will help improve traffic flow and alleviate congestion near the project area; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos desires to complete the construction of the Project in an expeditious manner; and

WHEREAS, delegating and authorizing the City Manager to award the contract and execute the applicable contract documents will facilitate the expeditious and orderly construction of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Marcos hereby:

1. Finds that the Project is categorically exempt from the provisions of CEQA as an existing facility (Class 1) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines § 15301(c); and
2. Approves the construction documents for bid for the San Marcos Blvd. Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Rd. Project (CIP #ST005); and
3. Authorizes the advertisement for bid for the San Marcos Blvd. Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Rd. Project (CIP #ST005); and
4. Delegates to and authorizes the City Manager to award, negotiate, finalize, and execute the construction contract documents with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the San Marcos Blvd. Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Rd. Project (CIP #ST005).
