Comments via text message and/or social media (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, etc.), will not be accepted.

The City Clerk will read all email comments, provided that the reading will not exceed five (5) minutes, or such other time as the Council may provide, consistent with its ability to set time parameters for public comment at a Council meeting. If persons submitting comments do not want their comment to be read out loud at the meeting (not to exceed five minutes), they should note "Do Not Read Out Loud at Meeting" at the top of the email. All emailed comments received by 4:00 pm will be provided to the City Council members and included as "Supplemental Information" on the City's website prior to the meeting. Those comments received after 4:00 pm and prior to the close of public comment on the applicable agenda item will be added to the record and will be shared with the City Council members at the meeting.
