A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF SAN MARCOS AUTHORIZING A BUDGET
AMENDMENT TO FISCAL YEAR 25-26 OPERATING
BUDGET FOR THE AWARDED 2025 SAFE SAN
DIEGO GRANT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Burn Institute of San Diego, through a grant from San Diego Gas & Electric, is providing 2025 SAFE San Diego grant funds to Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) programs in San Diego County to aid in supporting emergency preparedness and safety; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2025 SAFE San Diego grant allocation is \$5,000 for the City of San Marcos; and

WHEREAS, the SAFE San Diego grant funds do not require City matching funds, all grant-related expenditures are post-receipt of the awarded amount; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of San Marcos to participate in this program to enhance education and emergency preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AS FOLLOWS:

The City Council authorizes the appropriation of \$5,000 in revenue and \$5,000 in expenses amending the fiscal year 25-26 Operating Budget and delegates authority to the City Manager to approve the budget amendments as they relate to the receipt of the awarded grant funds.
