A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONSENT TO SELF-INSURE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LIABILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos (City) is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City is a chartered municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it to be in the best interest of the City to authorize such application and designate representatives to execute the necessary documents.

WHEREAS, there are significant financial and administrative advantages for the City to provide workers' compensation coverage for its employees through the Excess Workers' Compensation Protection Program of California JPIA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Marcos as follows:

SECTION 1. The City is hereby authorized and empowered to make application to the Director of Industrial Relations, State of California, for a Certificate of Consent to Self-Insure workers' compensation liabilities.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required for such application and to take any additional actions as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.
