RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS APPROVING CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER TO FINALIZE THE CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS, AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BID, AND DELEGATING TO AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD, FINALIZE, AND EXECUTE THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR THE RANCHO SANTA FE PAVEMENT RESTORATION PROJECT (CIP #ST014)

WHEREAS, construction documents for the Rancho Santa Fe Pavement Restoration Project (CIP #ST014, "Project") have been substantially completed; and

WHEREAS, the Project improvements will include pavement rehabilitation, construction of intersection signal improvements, new buffered bike lane striping, and ADA improvements on Rancho Santa Fe Road between Melrose Drive and Lake Ridge Drive; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos desires to complete the construction of the Project in an expeditious manner; and

WHEREAS, delegating and authorizing the City Manager to award the contract and execute the applicable contract documents will facilitate the expeditious and orderly construction of the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Marcos hereby:

1. Approves the construction documents for bid for the Rancho Santa Fe Pavement Restoration Project (CIP #ST014); and
2. Authorizes the City Engineer to finalize the construction documents; and
3. Authorizes the advertisement for bid for the Rancho Santa Fe Pavement Restoration Project (CIP #ST014); and
4. Delegates to and authorizes the City Manager to award, finalize, and execute the construction contract documents with the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the Rancho Santa Fe Pavement Restoration Project (CIP #ST014).
