RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS
APPROVING A TEMPORARY WAIVER OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF
RESOLUTION 2002-5865 FOR CIP PROJECT TR008

WHEREAS, City Council previously adopted Resolution 2002-5865 which specifies work within the San Marcos Boulevard public right-of-way which necessitates a lane closure, in either direction, must occur during nighttime off-peak hours or on weekends; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will require lane closures to replace the existing traffic signal backplates with retroreflective backplates; and

WHEREAS, City staff has reviewed the closure and had determined it necessary to accommodate the work in an expeditious, safe, and efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The requirements of Resolution 2002-5865 are waived to allow for the closure of San Marcos Boulevard as part of TR008 as approved by the City Engineer and required for the expeditious delivery of the project.
2. Any lane closures shall be minimized, allowing for lanes to be reopened at the earliest possible time.
