A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS APPROVING A TEMPORARY NIGHTTIME WORK HOUR WAIVER FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF RESOLUTION NO. 2002-5865 FOR THE SAN MARCOS BOULEVARD DUAL LEFT-TURN LANE EXTENSION AT RANCHO SANTA FE ROAD PROJECT (CIP# ST005)

WHEREAS, the City Council previously adopted Resolution No. 2002-5865 which specifies that work within the San Marcos Boulevard public right-of-way from Knoll Road to the westerly city limits which necessitates a lane closure in either direction must occur during nighttime off-peak hours or on weekends; and

WHEREAS, construction for the San Marcos Boulevard Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Road Project (CIP# ST005) will require lane closures to extend the westbound dual left-turn lanes on San Marcos Boulevard approaching Rancho Santa Fe Road; and

WHEREAS, City staff has evaluated the need for daytime work hours on San Marcos Boulevard and determined that it is necessary to accommodate the above-described work in an expeditious and efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. The requirements of Resolution No. 2002-5865 are temporarily waived to allow daytime work hours for the San Marcos Boulevard Dual Left-Turn Lane Extension at Rancho Santa Fe Road Project (CIP# ST005) as approved by the City Engineer and required for the expeditious delivery of the project.

2. Lane closures shall be minimized, allowing for lanes to be reopened at the earliest possible time.
