A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS ADOPTING THE CITY'S PY 2025/2029 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND PY 2025/2026 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR PURPOSES OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos participates in the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, and

WHEREAS, Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds are to be used for the development of viable urban communities, by providing decent housing, suitable living environments, and expanded economic opportunities, primarily for low- and moderate-income persons, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Part 91 of Title 24 of the Code of Federal Regulations, HUD requires the City to have a Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan which details the needs of the community, strategic goals and the planned use of CDBG funding to address those needs; and

WHEREAS, the Consolidated Plan must be approved by the City Council every five years and the Annual Action Plan must be approved by the City Council annually.

WHEREAS, once HUD provides the 2025-2026 funding allocation, the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan will be adjusted prior to submission to HUD.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Marcos, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.
- The City Council adopts the attached PY 2025/2029 Consolidated Plan and PY 2025/2026
 Annual Action Plan for CDBG funding purposes and approves submitting the plan to HUD.
- 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to sign all appropriate certificates of said Plans and execute all documents related thereto.
