

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS,  
CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE FY 2013-14  
PUBLIC FACILITIES FEES ANNUAL REPORT

WHEREAS, California Government Code Sections 66001 and 66006  
require local agencies to provide certain information relative to the collection and  
expenditures of fees imposed as a condition of approval of development projects;  
and

WHEREAS, the information relating to the collection and expenditure of  
fees imposed as a condition of approval of development projects has been  
available to the public at least fifteen (15) days prior to the meeting; and

WHEREAS, the information to make the required findings can be found in  
the Fiscal Year 2014-15 Capital Improvement Program budget on file with the  
City Clerk; and further, these findings need to be made in conjunction with the  
public information required by Government Code Section 66006.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of  
San Marcos, California, as follows:

1. That the above recitals are true and correct.
2. That the purpose to which the developer fee is to be put has been  
identified in Exhibit "A".
3. That a reasonable relationship has been demonstrated between the  
fee and purpose for which it is charged.

4. That all sources and amounts of funding anticipated to complete financing on incomplete improvements have been identified.
5. That the approximate dates on which the funding referred to above are expected to be expended from the appropriate fund have been identified.
6. To the extent that Government Code Sections 66001 and 66006 require findings to be made by the local agency, the above referenced responses shall constitute said findings of the City of San Marcos.
