RESOLUTION NO. 2017-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AWARDING A CONTRACT TO BRAUN NORTHWEST, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) NEW TYPE III AMBULANCE AND SUPPORT EQUIPMENT.

WHEREAS, the City Council approved the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 Adopted Budget, which includes funding for the purchase of one (1) New Type III ambulance and associated support equipment, as part of the Vehicle & Equipment Replacement Fund schedule; and

WHEREAS, the San Marcos Fire Department has prepared specifications for a Type III ambulance and associated support equipment; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the new ambulance will help maintain a standardized fleet of modern up-to-date ambulances and extend the ambulances' years of service; and

WHEREAS, The City Attorney has determined that the California Government Code empowers the City to acquire equipment from vendors through a competitive bid process. The Department's "piggy-back" contract is based on a contract with the City of Pasadena, which was competitively bid and formally awarded to Braun Northwest, Inc.

WHEREAS, Braun Northwest, Inc. is also the original manufacturer of all ambulances in the Department's ambulance fleet, which, in addition to price, is one of the Department's determining factors in selecting Braun Northwest, Inc. for the ambulance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to engage in the above-described program for the purchase of one (1) new 2017 Type III ambulance as specified by the San Marcos Fire Department.
- 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to expend the sum of:
