Compounding these challenges, my wife of 30 years recently filed for divorce, seeking a path separate from our marriage. This has placed an emotional strain on my family, particularly on my daughter, and has added a layer of stress that affects my focus and daily responsibilities.

I have been an active and consistent business owner in San Marcos since the early 2000s, always striving to meet my obligations on time. I respectfully ask that you take my circumstances into consideration and grant a waiver or reduction of the fine. The past couple of years have been exceptionally trying, and I am hopeful that you will find compassion in understanding my situation.

Thank you for taking the time to review my appeal. I deeply appreciate your consideration and understanding. Please let me know if there is any further information you require.
