

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF 2024 SAFE SAN DIEGO GRANT FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT TO THE FISCAL YEAR 24-25 OPERATING BUDGET

WHEREAS, the Burn Institute, through a grant from San Diego Gas & Electric, is providing 2024 SAFE San Diego grant funding to Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) programs in San Diego County to aid in supporting emergency preparedness and safety; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2024 SAFE San Diego grant allocation is \$3,000 for the City of San Marcos; and

WHEREAS, the SAFE San Diego grant funding does not require City matching funds, all grant-related expenditures are post-receipt of the awarded amount; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of San Marcos to participate in this program to enhance education and emergency preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City to accept the \$3,000 in grant funds from the Burn Institute.
2. The City Council further authorizes the appropriation of \$3,000 in revenue and \$3,000 in expenses, amending the FY 24-25 Operating Budget accordingly, and delegates authority to the City Manager to approve the budget amendments as they relate to the acceptance of such grant funding.
