A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN MARCOS AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE
2021 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM
(SHSGP) FUNDS

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, through the California Office of Emergency Services, is providing FY 2021 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) funding to support the implementation of risk-driven, capabilities-based State Homeland Security Strategies to address capability targets; and

WHEREAS, the approved 2021 SHSGP allocation is \$63,280; and

WHEREAS, the SHSGP funds do not require City matching funds, all grant-related expenditures are one-hundred percent reimbursable, and the City shall incur no direct costs; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of San Marcos to participate in this program to enhance education and emergency preparedness.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

The City Manager, Finance Director and Fire Chief are authorized to execute for and on behalf of the City of San Marcos, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, any actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining federal financial assistance provided by the federal Department of Homeland Security and sub-granted through the State of California.
