## **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-XXXX**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS, CALIFORNIA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 FUNDING BY SB 1, THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017), was passed by the California Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 to address significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB1 designates funding via the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA) to fund basic road maintenance, rehabilitation, and critical safety projects on local streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the city residents are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt by resolution a list of projects proposed to receive fiscal year funding from the RMRA to include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City will receive an estimated \$2,510,128 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2025-26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the sixth year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding, and such funding enables the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate streets, and add active transportation infrastructure throughout the City this year and similar projects in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City has undergone a robust public process to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and costeffective projects that also meet community priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the 2018 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City's streets and roads are in good condition and this revenue will help us preserve the overall quality of our road system over the next decade; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials, and practices, will have significant positive impacts on residents and visitors statewide.

**NOW, THEREFORE** IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED, AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of San Marcos, State of California, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The following list of projects will be funded in part or solely with Fiscal Year 2025-26 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

**Project Title**: Annual Surface Seal Capital Improvement Program Project, CIP ST011

**Project Description**: This project will focus on rehabilitation and preventative pavement maintenance activities Citywide, with specific areas prioritized based on Pavement Condition Index (PCI) data.

**Project Location**: The project will take place in areas of the City with the highest concentration of streets prioritized for slurry sealing, based on current PCI evaluations.

**Estimated Project Schedule**: Start (8/2025) – Completion (9/2026) based on the component being funded with RMRA funds **Estimated Project Useful Life**: 10 Years

**Project Title:** Roadway Rehabilitation Program Group 1, CIP ST022 **Project Description:** This project will focus on rehabilitation of deferred maintenance streets and the supplementation of the City's existing preventative pavement maintenance program, to extend pavement life and improve roadway conditions.

**Project Location:** Woodland Parkway, Rancheros Drive, and Barham Drive. **Estimated Project Schedule:** Start (7/2025) – Completion (9/2026), based on

the components being funded with RMRA funds. **Estimated Project Useful Life:** 15 Years

3. The following previously proposed and adopted projects may also utilize Fiscal Year 2025-26 Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues in their delivery. With the relisting of these projects in the adopted fiscal year resolution, the City is reaffirming to the public and the State our intent to fund these projects with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues:

**Project Title**: Annual Surface Seal Capital Improvement Program Project **Project Description**: The project will focus on rehabilitation and preventative pavement maintenance activities throughout the City.

**Project Location**: The project location will cover pavement activities on Las Posas Road, Linda Vista Drive, Pacific Street, and various residential streets citywide..

**Estimated Project Schedule**: Start (05/2025) – Completion (9/2025) based on the component being funded with RMRA funds **Estimated Project Useful Life**: 10 Years
