

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-XXXX

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
MARCOS AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF USED OIL PAYMENT
PROGRAM APPLICATIONS AND RELATED AUTHORIZATIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Public Resources Code § 48690 the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle), formerly known as the California Integrated Waste Management Board, has established the Used Oil Payment Program to make payments to qualifying jurisdictions for implementation of their used oil programs; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle's procedures for administering the Used Oil Payment Program require, among other things, an Applicant's governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of the Used Oil Payment Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of San Marcos is authorized to submit a Used Oil Payment Program application to CalRecycle; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager, Acting City Manager, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized as Signature Authority to execute all documents necessary to implement and secure payment under the Used Oil Payment Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Development Services/City Engineer, or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the City of San Marcos all documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, annual reports including expenditure reports and amendments necessary to secure said payments to support the City's Used Oil Collection Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization is effective for five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution.
