## **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AUTHORIZING THE SAN MARCOS FIRE DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO NEIGHBORHOOD REINVESTMENT GRANT.

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos (City) recognizes the critical impact of a fully functional Emergency Operations Center (EOC) to ensure the safety and security of its residents during emergencies and disasters; and

WHEREAS, the current power supply at the EOC has been identified as inadequate to meet the demands of maintaining continuous operation, thereby compromising the effectiveness of the EOC in times of crisis; and

WHEREAS, the County of San Diego (County) encourages and supports one-time funding projects that positively impact the quality of life in our communities through the Neighborhood Reinvestment Grant Program, which is available to public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to apply for \$65,000 in grant funding through the County's Neighborhood Reinvestment Grant Program to secure the necessary funding to complete the EOC Power Project to ensure a reliable and sustainable power solutions at the EOC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The City Council confirms that the City is a public agency under the laws of the State of California;
- 2. The filing of an application with the County of San Diego for Neighborhood Reinvestment Program funding during the County's current fiscal year is approved; and
- 3. The City Manager, Fire Chief, or Finance Director are authorized to sign and execute a grant agreement with the County of San Diego for Neighborhood Reinvestment fund for the current fiscal year.
