RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN MARCOS  
ADOPTING A LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM FOR PROPOSITION 84  
FUNDED PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City of San Marcos ("City") has been awarded a grant through the Statewide Park and Community Revitalization Grant Program ("Grant") funded under Proposition 84; and

WHEREAS, the City may apply for additional grants and funds made available through Proposition 84 in the future; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to have a certified Labor Compliance Program in place and active prior to receiving funds for project related construction work as described in the Grant funded by Proposition 84; and

WHEREAS, the City must designate employees and/or consultants to implement the program to administer the Grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council of the City of San Marcos has determined it is in the best interest of the City to comply with and adopt a Labor Compliance Program and directs staff to develop, maintain, and implement this program in compliance with the California Department of Industrial Relations and applicable portions of the California Labor Code, Section 1771.5(b) and following, and hereby adopts the same.
